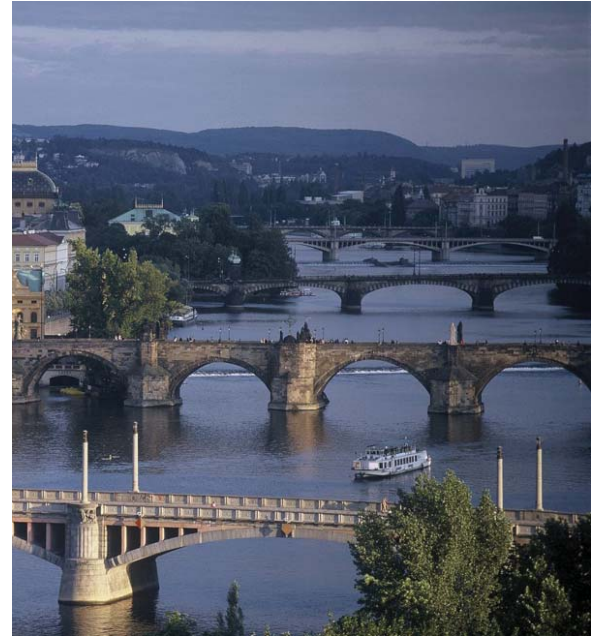

Meet your coaches and teammates as you prepare for international competition and your journey abroad.

#### August 3 - Training Session #2 Overnight Flight to Europe

After a second day of practice and training, depart with your team to Prague.

#### August 4 - Arrive in Prague

Prague, the 'City of a Hundred Spires', is renowned for its elegant architecture, historic landmarks and medieval streets. Our tour visits the impressive hilltop Hradcany Quarter, Prague's world famous castle, and St Vitus' Cathedral, a Gothic edifice that took centuries to complete.

#### August 5 - Prague Castle and Old Town

Our sight-seeing tour continues with a tour of the Old Town, lined with lavishly decorated houses. Here we see the Astronomical Clock, the 18th century Church of St Nicholas and the beautiful Goltz-Kinsky Palace. We continue to the medieval Charles Bridge, which spans the River Vltava and links the Old Town with the Castle District. In the afternoon, play your first game against foreign competition.

GAME ONE 

#### August 6 - Terezin Memorial

Today, take a short drive north to the Terezin Memorial for a half day sight-seeing tour of this World War II concentration camp and Jewish ghetto located outside Prague. We take a powerful tour of both the ghetto and the concentration camp, which are both eerily preserved in their 1940's state.

GAME TWO 

#### August 7 - Transfer to Vienna

Today, we depart Prague for Vienna, a city of brilliant musicians, Baroque art, incredible architecture and velvet-clad coffeehouses.


#### August 8 - Vienna Sightseeing

Join a professional tour guide on a sight-seeing adventure around the infamous Ringstraße, the series of boulevards circling the city. Pass the world-famous Opera House and the 450-foot Gothic St. Stephan's Cathedral, Vienna's most adored symbol.

#### August 9 - Vienna Schonbrunn Palace

Today we will visit Schönbrunn, the former summer residence of the imperial family. It is considered one of the most beautiful baroque palaces in Europe.

### **Tour Cost**

\$4,400 per player

### **Tour Dates**

August 2 - 12, 2009

### **Tour Eligibility**

Any student-athlete who has completed at least one full academic year.

### **Roundtrip airfare**

All flights are scheduled aboard major international carriers.

Outbound: Newark (EWR) to Prague  
Return: Vienna to Newark (EWR)

### **Hotel Accommodations**

Four or five star hotels are used.

Two players per room:

- Prague (3 nights)
- Vienna (5 nights)

### **Ground Transportation**

Private motorcoach is used for airport transfers, gameday transfers and sight-seeing; All transfers between cities are included.

### **Meals Included**

Buffet breakfast at the hotel is included daily; A generous stipend for lunch and dinners is provided for each player.

### **Cultural Tours**

All sight-seeing, excursions and entrance fees on the itinerary are included.

### **Game Information**

Four (4) games against foreign competition are guaranteed and up to five (5) may be scheduled. Competition levels vary and may include:

- U21 National teams
- Semi-professional clubs
- Country All-Star teams
- FIBA Europe select teams
- ULEB select teams
- Euroleague professional teams

*All practices and games are led by Head Coach Guy Rancourt and staff.*

### **About the East Coast All-Stars**

The East Coast All-Stars is a select group of 12 collegiate basketball players chosen to represent their universities in global competition. The team, led by Coach Guy Rancourt, will be embarking on their third summer tour across Europe. In 2006, the team toured and competed across Denmark and Sweden. In 2007, the All-Star team played throughout Holland and Belgium. In the Summer of 2009, the tradition will continue in Eastern Europe. The East Coast All-Stars is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for a student athlete. It gives them an opportunity to face unique competition while representing their university and sport overseas. Most importantly, the athletes engage in a rare and unforgettable cultural experience.
